Young Musicians are invited to compete in our sixth biennial competition which is jointly sponsored by **The John M. Parrott Foundation** and **Quinte Symphony**.

Quinte Symphony is a community orchestra consisting of approximately 45 professional and amateur musicians from the greater Quinte area. The orchestra performs music from the standard orchestral repertoire and favourites from other genres to appreciative audiences in the Quinte region. Rehearsals and performances take place in Belleville.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. To be eligible you must have been born in **1986 or after**. You must reside, or have your permanent residency in any of the four counties of: Hastings, Prince Edward, Northumberland or Lennox and Addington.
2. Members, and former members of Quinte Symphony are eligible to enter if they were born in **1986** or after.
3. The competition is open to all **instrumental concerti** and **works for voice and orchestra**, which may include opera arias, concert arias, or concert repertoire.
4. The orchestral score must be available for rental. The instrumentation must not exceed: 3222 4230 timpani and percussion.
5. The jury will consist of at least two adjudicators. The jury has the right to decline any piece that is not suitable for the orchestra. If this occurs, the soloist will be notified by **May 1, 2010** and will be eligible to choose another piece for the competition. All decisions made by the jury are final and without appeal. The jury reserves the right not to award a winner.
6. The contestant will play a portion of the work at the discretion of the jury. Each contestant will provide his or her own **accompanist** for the competition as well as a **copy of the score** for each jury member before his/her presentation. Maximum time allotted for each contestant is 30 minutes.
7. The winner will be awarded a cash prize of **\$250**. The winner, at the Musical Director's discretion, may be asked to perform the piece with the Quinte Symphony during the 2010-2011 season (date to be determined). The soloist will be required to attend at least three rehearsals leading up to the concert.
8. Previous winners are not eligible to enter this competition.

APPLICATION PROCESS

1. The deadline for application: Applications must be postmarked by **April 16, 2010**.
2. The competition will take place on **Sunday, June 27, 2010** starting at 10am at Albert College Chapel, 160 Dundas Street West, Belleville. Each contestant will be notified of his/her performance time in advance.

3. An entry fee of \$10 is payable with your application.
4. Please submit a one-page resumé briefly outlining your musical accomplishments, education, competitions, past performances, etc.
